#### **Bracket Play**

We will run ahead of schedule, if possible. See brackets on the last page for more information.

The school listed under lines/bench during pool play, and the school in parentheses in bracket play, will be responsible for providing 4 workers. Those workers will cover lines/bench (a person to operate the scoreboard, and a person to track the libero, and 2 line judges). (A1) means the 1<sup>st</sup> place team from Pool A.

\* A coin flip will be used to determine the choice of home team and side in the first set. A second coin flip will determine who serves and who receives. Those options are automatically reversed for game #2. Pool play will consist of best two out of three sets with the first two sets to 21 points (must win by two). If a third set is necessary, that will go to 15 points and the coin flip process will be repeated. Bracket play will play 2 out of 3 to 25 (3<sup>rd</sup> to 15).

**Warm up protocol:** All teams will be given a 17-minute warmup (5-6-6). Warmups after this will be six minutes (3-3) (We will provide warm-up balls for all contests).

#### TIE-BREAKER CRITERIA FOR DETERMINING PLACE IN POOL:

- 1. Match Record
- 2. Set Record Winning Percentage
- 3. Point Spread vs. Tied Teams (Using the first two sets played)
- 4. Point Spread in All Pool Sets (Using the first two sets played)
- 5. One Set Playoff to 15

#### **SPECIAL NOTES FOR ARRIVAL ON SATURDAY:**

Enter using the driveway off of Forest Drive SE.

Have the bus drivers drop your team off on the loop drive (arcade) by the tennis courts & cafeteria – JUST FOLLOW THE SIGNS TO THE CAFETERIA. Go in the doors to the school by the cafeteria and drop off your coolers and extra bags in the cafeteria. 

The school buses should park in the NORTH lot off Forest Drive (near the tennis courts).


When it is time to leave, the bus drivers may pick you up where they dropped you off – on the loop drive.
